



Clewer Green Sports Day

Revised timings

The advice from Public Health England which has been sent out by the DfE, is that children 'should not take part in vigorous physical activity on days when temperatures are in excess of 30C'. As tomorrow is forecast to reach 28C, Sports Day will go ahead.

A decision will be made on Tuesday morning, and parents will be informed, as to whether we will follow the format below.

10.00	Sports Day activities on field
10.30	Children return to their classrooms.
11.45	Parents welcome to join us from 11.45
11.45	Foundation Stage lunchtime starts
11.50	Year 1 and 2 lunchtime starts
12.00	Year 3 and 4 lunchtime starts
12.30	Children return to their classrooms for afternoon registration and a toilet break. During this time parents are requested to pack up their picnics and assemble on the chairs by the running track ready for the afternoon races.
12.40	Running races begin Parents' chairs are situated along edge of the running track. <i>Please remain on this side of the track.</i> Race order: Romans, Celts, Angles, Saxons, Normans, Vikings, Tudors, Stuarts, Georgians and Victorians.
1.10	House Relay Arundel, Hever, Leeds and Windsor Houses will compete in a whole school relay race! This will take place on the running track.
1.30	Trophy presentation to winning House The children will have accumulated points throughout the morning activities. These will be counted up and the Harcourt Trophy will be presented to the winning House Captains.
1.45	End of Sports Day. Children to return to their classes.
2.00	Home time. Children will be dismissed from classrooms as usual. Please do not take your child from the Sports field – they will go back to their classrooms with their teachers to collect their belongings and be dismissed through their usual external classroom doors. If you collect your child from the front playground, then please walk back round to the front of the school via the side green gate. If you are not able to take your child home then they will remain in school until they are dismissed at 3.30 as usual.

TOILETS

If you wish to use the toilet, please enter the school building through the door under the covered walkway. The external door will be kept open, and the fob security for the internal door (this door only) will be deactivated. If a younger sibling needs to use the toilet, please use the allocated adult toilets so parents do not enter the children's toilets. Children will use their own toilets, as usual.
